
ACCESS TO THE THRONE OF GRACE

¹ Therefore, since we have been MADE righteous (JUSTIFIED) through HIS faithfulness, we have PEACE WITH OUR GOD through Jesus Christ. ² WE HAVE ACCESS by FAITH into THIS GRACE in which we stand THROUGH HIM, and we BOAST (REJOICE) in the hope of God's glory.

¹ Now after the Sabbath, toward the dawn of the first day of the week, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary went to see the tomb. ² And behold, there was a great earthquake, for an angel of the Lord descended from heaven and came and rolled back the stone and sat on it.




The resurrection has given us free access because it has changed who has access to God.

²⁰ As God's household, you are built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets with Christ Jesus Himself as the cornerstone.



— What they had to do to gain access to God.






Jesus answered them, "This is the work of God, that you believe in Him whom He has sent."







Access to God through the resurrection provides peace & purpose.



1. Peace



"Man cannot have peace with himself, nor be truly happy, unless he has peace with God."



¹⁷ If Christ hasn't been raised, then your <u>FAITH IS</u> <u>WORTHLESS</u> [useless, pointless, ineffective]; you are <u>STILL IN YOUR SINS</u>, ¹⁸ and what's more, those who have died in Christ are gone forever.





19 If we have a hope in Christ only in this life, then we deserve to be pitied more than anyone else. 20 BUT IN FACT CHRIST HAS BEEN RAISED FROM THE DEAD. He's the first crop of the harvest of those who have died.





²¹ For as **by a man came death**, by a man has come also the **resurrection of the dead**. ²² For as in **Adam all die**, so also in **Christ shall ALL BE MADE ALIVE**.

2. Purpose



Resurrection is not a consoling opium, soothing us with the promise of a better world in the hereafter. It is the energy for a rebirth of THIS life. The hope doesn't point to another world. It is focused on the redemption of this one.
