- Does not wisdom call?
 Does not understanding raise her voice?
- 2 On the heights beside **the way**, at the **crossroads** she takes her stand;
- 3 beside the gates in front of the town, at the entrance of the portals she cries aloud:









- "I, wisdom, dwell with prudence, and I find knowledge and discretion.
- The fear of the LORD is hatred of evil. 13 Pride and arrogance and the way of evil and perverted speech I hate.
- I have counsel and sound wisdom; 14 I have insight; I have strength.



- 10 Fear of the Lord is the foundation of wisdom.

 Knowledge of the Holy One results in good judgment.
- 11 Wisdom will multiply your days and add years to your life.
- If you become wise, you will be the one to benefit.

 If you scorn wisdom, you will be the one to suffer.

- 15 calling to those who pass by, who are going straight on their way,

- And to him who lacks sense she says,
- 17 "Stolen water is sweet, and bread eaten in secret is pleasant."
- 18 But he does not know that the **dead are there**, that her guests are in the depths of Sheol.






