Whereas, James, S. Cory of Saline County, Nebraska

has deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States a CERTIFICATE OF THE REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE at Lincoln, Nebraska, whereby it appears that FULL PAYMENT has been made by the said James, S. Cory according

to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making provision for the sale of the public lands," for the East half of the North East quarter of Section four in Township eight North of Range four East in the district of land subject to sale at Lincoln, Nebraska, containing Eighty acres.

according to the OFFICIAL PLAN of the Survey of the said lands, returned to the GENERAL OFFICE by the Surveyor General, which said Tract has been purchased by the said

James, S. Cory

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said James, S. Cory and to his heirs, the said Tract above described; To Have and to Hold unto the said James, S. Cory and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony whereof, U. S. Grant PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,

have caused these letters to be made Patent, and Seal of the GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.

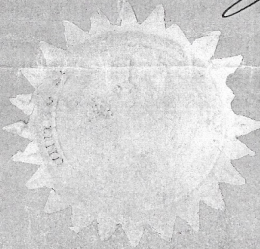
