


- "A little SLEEP, a little slumber, a little LYING DOWN with folded arms—"

¹⁰ Even when we were with you we were giving you this command: "If anyone doesn't want to work, they shouldn't eat." 11 We hear that some of you are living an undisciplined life. They aren't working, but they are meddling in other people's business. 12 By the Lord Jesus Christ, we command and encourage such people to work quietly and put their own food on the table.



- Don't exalt yourself in the presence of the king, or stand in the place of important people,
- because it is better that he say to you, "Come up here," than to be demoted before a ruler.



29 Do you see a man skillful in his work? HE WILL STAND BEFORE KINGS;

he will not stand before obscure men.

²² Slaves [bond servants, workers], obey your earthly masters in everything you do. Try to please them all the time, not just when they are watching you. **Serve them sincerely because of your reverent fear of the Lord**. ²³ Work willingly at whatever you do, as though

you were working for the Lord rather than for people.

²⁴ Remember that the Lord will give you an inheritance as your reward, and that the Master you are serving is Christ. ²⁵ But if you do what is wrong, you will be paid back for the wrong you have done. For God has no favorites. 1 Masters, be just and fair to your slaves [bond servants, workers]. Remember that you also have a Master—in heaven.
